## Importing User-Defined Groups from Deep Freeze Enterprise

The Enterprise Console for Deep Freeze and Faronics Anti-Executable can be used to define specific groups in which to arrange workstations.

Users who already have deployed Deep Freeze and configured specific User-Defined groups, can now export these groups to be used in Anti-Executable's Console as well.

To export the User Defined Groups from the Deep Freeze Enterprise Console into the Anti-Executable Enterprise Console, complete the following steps.

1. Browse to the file *XXXX\_Groups.DF5* on the workstation running the Deep Freeze Console. Ensure the Console is not running.  
*XXXX* is the port number controlled by this Deep Freeze Console, e.g. *1971\_Groups.DF5*.
2. Copy this file.
3. Browse to the file *XXXX\_Groups.FX* on the workstation running Anti-Executable Enterprise and delete it if it exists. Ensure the Anti-Executable Enterprise Console is not running.  
*XXXX* is the port number controlled by this Anti-Executable Console, e.g. *8825\_Groups.FX*.
4. Paste the file copied on step 2.
5. Rename this file as *XXXX\_Groups.FX*, e.g. *8825\_Groups.FX*.
6. Run the Anti-Executable Console.

The Anti-Executable User-Defined Groups should be the same as the Deep Freeze Enterprise Console's User-Defined Groups.
